Unlike the great tradition of mural painting in India that has largely vanished, we have an abundance of folios from illustrated manuscripts. These were commissioned by various royal courts and other patrons over more than eight centuries. The subjects of these manuscripts range from mythology and love poetry to historical narratives and albums with portraits and nature studies. Over this long span of time, the Indian painter repeatedly succeeded in creating worlds of enchantment and wonder, devotion and worldly pleasure, eroticism and romance in superbly rendered gestures.

In his presentation, Prof. Suresh Chabria, film and art historian, will speak about some of the most important schools of Indian miniature painting. The talk will be illustrated with exquisite images.
